- BUDGET & FINANCE COMMITTEE:** Chaired by the GPBR Treasurer, this important group meets regularly to review the state of current board finances. The group is also empowered with the important task of recommending annual budgets. Meetings held no less than quarterly.
- COMMUNITY OUTREACH COMMITTEE:** This committee works to ensure that GPBR maintains compliance with the NAR Core Standards requirements by identifying areas for community involvement and ways to enhance the REALTOR® image within the community. Meetings are held monthly.
- EDUCATION COMMITTEE:** Discuss, identify and promote educational opportunities to be included in our General Membership Meeting programs or as designation/certification courses or other industry-related classes/seminars/workshops designed to support the reputation of an industry professional connoted by being a GPBR member. Meetings are held monthly.
- FAIR HOUSING & DIVERSITY COMMITTEE:** Help organize informative events and educational opportunities that provide insight into the value and benefits of Fair Housing and Diversity awareness. Committee chair is also a member of the Education Committee. Meeting frequency may vary.
- GOLF OUTING TASK FORCE:** Take part in a fun-filled networking opportunity, open to both GPBR members and the public, by planning and promoting one of our most popular yearly events. Golf outing takes place in early September with meetings as needed starting in early Spring.
- GOVERNMENTAL AFFAIRS COMMITTEE:** Participation in this committee is ideal for those with an interest in public policy and issues that confront REALTORS® at the local, state and national levels. Committee members also conduct "candidate interviews" during the election cycle at all levels with those running for elected office in the communities our members serve. Regular meetings are held monthly; additional meetings may be held as necessary based on political events and activities.
- GRIEVANCE COMMITTEE:** Review all Arbitration and Ethics Filings that come into the board and decide if hearings should be held by a Professional Standards Panel. Requirements include a minimum commitment of three years participation and attendance at one annual meeting to review updates or changes to the NAR Code of Ethics. Additional meetings held as needed when complaints are received.
- HOME, GARDEN & LIFESTYLE EXPO TASK FORCE:** Take part in an excellent networking opportunity while helping with the organization and execution of this highly popular event. Designed to promote property ownership and local businesses in our surrounding communities, the Expo takes place in March. Meetings held as needed starting in late Fall.
- INSTALLATION & HOLIDAY PARTY TASK FORCE:** Join us in planning the Installation of next year's Board of Directors, which takes place in conjunction with our holiday party at a fun and festive gala reception held in December at the Grosse Pointe Yacht Club. Meetings held as needed beginning in August.
- MEMBER SERVICES COMMITTEE:** The purpose of this committee is to identify the needs of GPBR members (including brokers, agents, appraisers, and affiliates) and explore and develop new services and/or restructure existing services in an effort to ensure that those needs are being met. Meetings held monthly.
